

INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

Pursuant to Article 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679, the General Data Protection Regulation (also referred to as 'the Regulation'), we hereby inform you that the provision of the service you have requested, as well as the consequent fulfilment of the regulations and the related administrative and accounting requirements, entail the processing of certain personal data, more specifically, personal data referring to you (hereinafter referred to as 'your data' or 'your personal data'), by Marina di Loano S.p.A, in its capacity as data controller (hereinafter, the 'Controller').

The legal basis for the processing consists of the need to execute a contract to which you are a party and the need to fulfil the related legal obligations. Any processing for the purpose of protecting our rights, in the event of legal proceedings, shall take place on the basis of our legitimate interest.

The provision of your personal data is optional; however, failure to provide it may make it impossible to provide the requested service.

Your data will not be disseminated and will only be accessible to authorised and trained personnel; they will be processed according to logics and methods, including computerised ones, appropriate for the purposes pursued and subject to the adoption of appropriate security measures to guarantee their confidentiality, availability and integrity. Your data may be disclosed to external parties to whom we entrust the performance of activities on our behalf and with whom we enter into agreements governing the processing of data.

Your personal data will be processed for the time necessary for the provision of the service and subsequently stored for administrative and accounting purposes, in accordance with the terms established by the relevant regulations applicable to each case (generally, 10 years).

The privacy regulation (Article 15-22 of the Regulation) entitles you to access your personal data and to obtain their rectification, if inaccurate or incomplete, deletion, if unlawfully processed, and portability, if provided by you and if processed automatically and on the basis of a contract or consent (Article 20). The privacy regulation also entitles you to request the restriction of data processing, if the relevant conditions are met, and to object to data processing on the grounds of your particular situation. Please note that you can withdraw any consent you may have given at any time; withdrawal does not affect the lawfulness of the processing carried out up to that point.
